\$350 Stipends* available for all student participants!

The Student Water Challenge will award \$350 stipends* to 40 higher education students in Maine, organized in 2-4 person campus teams, to participate in a challenge aimed at solving a water-related problem. Teams will be required to participate in a kick-off training webinar, submit their Water Action Plans by November 26, 2018 and attend the final Student Water Challenge Palooza on December 1, 2018. At the Water Palooza each team will have an opportunity to network with students from other campuses, receive leadership and SENCER training, and give a summary presentation on their Water Action Plan. Each student will receive an additional \$50 to compensate for travel to the Water Challenge Palooza. This initiative is sponsored by Maine EPSCoR in partnership with Maine Campus Compact.

Each student team will develop an innovative **Water Action Plan** that addresses a water challenge in one of these topic areas:

- ◇ A plan to help educate and empower people in a low income area about a local water quality issue;
- ◇ A curriculum for K-12 students around local water issues such as water quality or storm runoff;
- ◇ Other pre-approved topic of your team's choice that addresses one of these areas: Water Quality, Ocean Acidification, Ocean Related Research, Aquaculture, Aquaponics, or Storm Water Runoff.
